



How does a School-based Traineeship work?

The flexible model of school-based traineeships allows students to complete their senior schooling, whilst in Years 11 and 12. Typically, a school-based trainee will attend work one day a week and school on four days a week. Attendance patterns are negotiated between the school, Registered Training Organisation, the student, and the employer.

Training is interactive, flexible, and interesting. Students are encouraged to reach their maximum potential knowing that their course has been specifically designed to give them the opportunity to learn practical skills and knowledge in conjunction with practical learning in the workplace.

How it works:

- Time is allocated throughout the school week for students to attend training and work
- Students are paid employees of the business
- The traineeship is partially funded for by the government
- · The employer receives funding from the government for each school-based trainee
- The student must complete 730 hours of employment (100 days minimum)
- · The student must complete regular training
- Training takes place at a convenient location for all parties
- · Training is competency based
- The student will have assignments throughout their training
